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# NEW STATUS BOARD

Effective 04/09/2019

VPH will be changing from the current Meditech “Physician Rounding List” to a new “Status Board” on Tuesday, April 9, 2019 to improve functionality for providers.

Increased Functionality includes:

- Providers may add or remove patients from their “cover” list
- Clinically relevant information is pushed to providers
- Patients may be sorted per field
- Sticky Note functionality allows providers to communicate important information
- Multiple Status Boards may be created for specialty specific information




### Adding Providers to Cover List

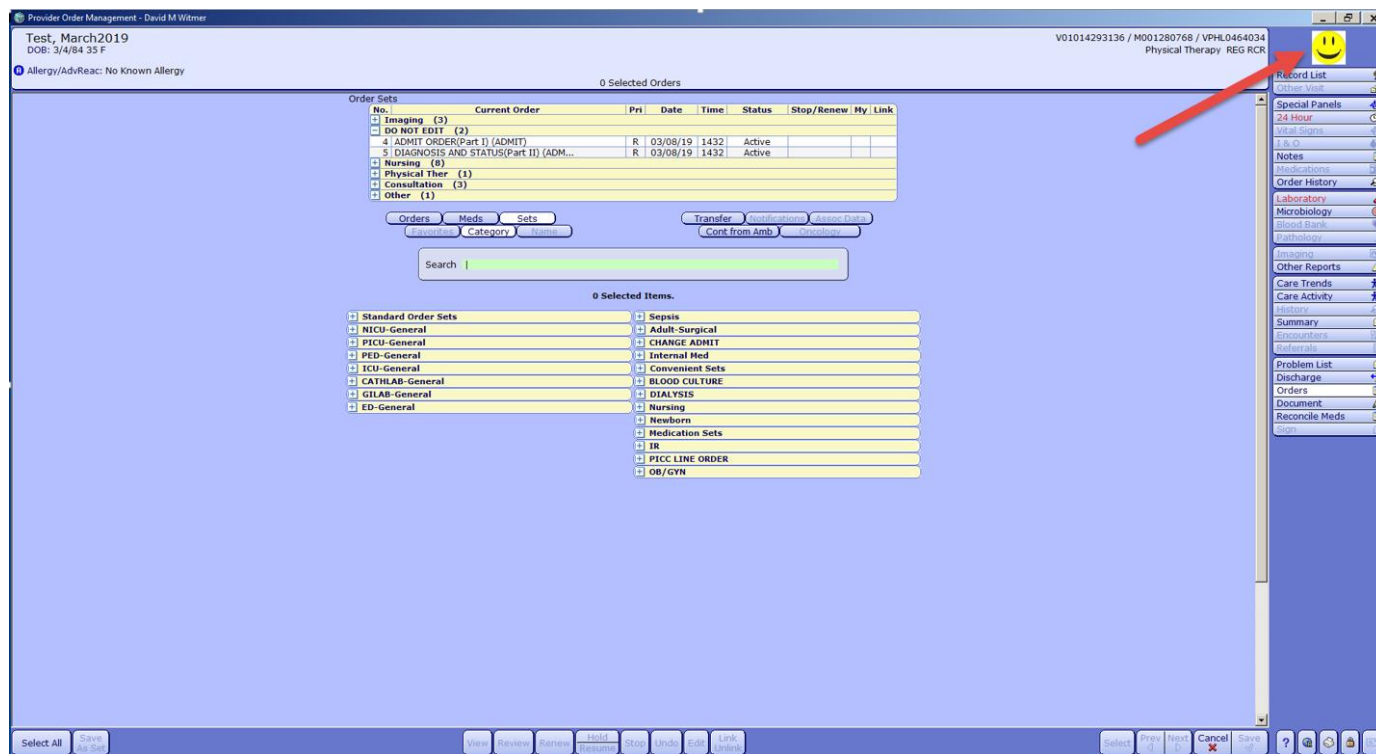

# New EMR Features

## Patient Pictures

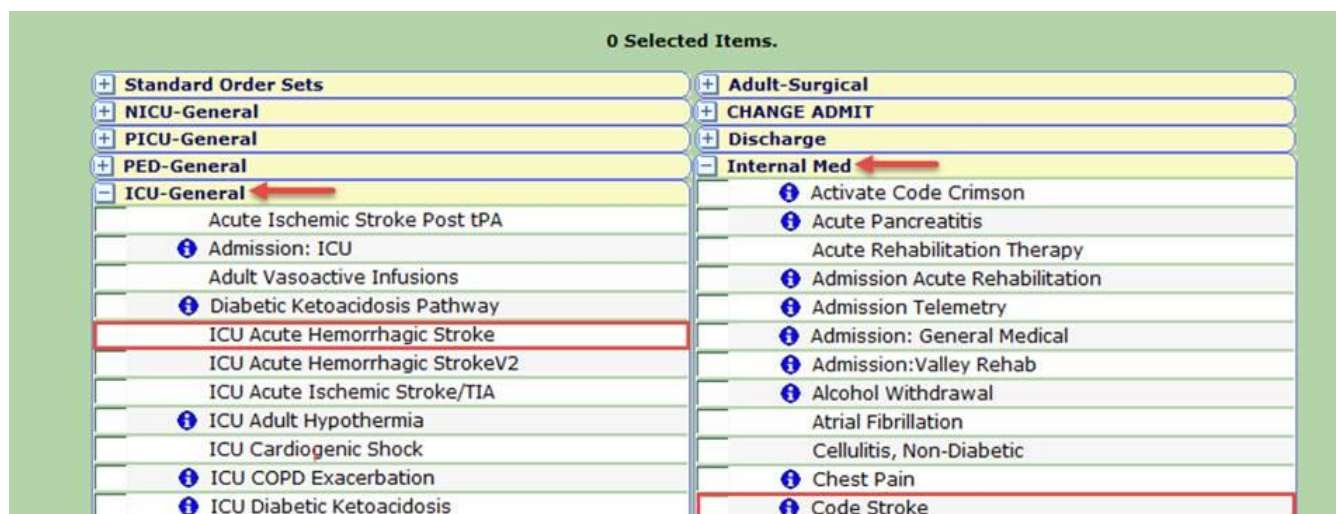
New Meditech feature will display the patient's picture in the upper right-hand corner of the screen. Providers can see the patient photo from any application (PDOC, POM, Med Reconciliation, Discharge, and Problem List) launched throughout the EMR.



## New Order Sets

**Code Stroke** - found in the Internal Med Order Group, to assist in the work-up and management of acute strokes in the inpatient setting

**ICU Acute Hemorrhagic Stroke** - revisions made to this set can be found in the ICU-General Order group



## New Templates

Consult Initial Nephrology, and Consult Follow-up Nephrology

Consult Initial Cardiology, and Consult Follow-up Cardiology

Consult Initial Neurology, and Consult Follow-up Neurology

### New Functionality:

- Physicians now may directly edit mid-level provider notes prior to signing. Meditech saves all versions.
- Date/Time editing is now incorporated into the Consult Date/Type/Reasons for improved visibility.
- CC: functionality is now included in the Assessment/Plan section for improved visibility.
- Labs will appear in the Objective Section.

### Design of Assessment/Plan Section:

- The Hospital Course section carries forward via (Demo Recall) information from initial notes through all the follow-up notes.
- The Problem(s) List is included for those that prefer to use the Problem List and take advantage of the qualifiers imbedded in the system.
- The Assessment/Plan (Daily) is designed for any daily documentation that does not require forwarding to subsequent notes.
- These three options are designed to offer flexibility to providers, in line with VPH's Electronic Documentation Policy.
